



Estuary View Medical Centre Public Transport Services

Estuary View Medical Centre (EV) Whitstable is served by several bus services which also link with other local bus routes and with Whitstable Railway Station. Current details are:

Stagecoach No. 4/6 service between Canterbury, Whitstable and Herne Bay runs twice-hourly in each direction via both Estuary View and Whitstable Railway Station*. Services are between about 09.00 and 18.00 on Mondays to Fridays (except Bank Holidays), and Saturdays.



Regent Coaches No. 638 service between Whitstable and Faversham calls at Estuary View on weekdays (except public holidays). This is roughly 2-hourly each way between 10.00 and 16.30, with variations on non-school days. (Saturday service does not include Estuary View).

Stagecoach 'Triangle' service runs every 15 minutes each way between Canterbury, Whitstable and Herne Bay, stopping at Canterbury Road about 600m east of EV.

Tesco bus service. Additionally, Whitstable Medical Practice is grateful to Tesco for including Estuary View in its **free 1/2 hourly bus service** via Swalecliffe, Tankerton, Harbour Street and the town centre from Tuesday to Friday. The first bus departs Harbour Street at 09.30 and then every half hour until 14.00. (This service is operated by Regent Coaches).

Note that there are convenient links between the above bus services and other local bus routes at shared bus stops in Whitstable and Tankerton.

* **The Whitstable Railway Station bus stop** is on its eastern approach road on the 'down side' of the station (Ramsgate direction). **Disabled travellers** are alerted to the stepped subway and footbridge links to platforms at Faversham, Whitstable, and Herne Bay stations.
