



Estuary View Minor Injuries Unit Virtual Fracture Clinic

We have introduced a new process for the treatment of stable fractures. It means that your X-rays and notes will be checked by an orthopaedic consultant or lead MIU practitioner within a few days of attending the MIU.

You will then be contacted to discuss the treatment plan or to book a face to face appointment in the fracture clinic.

Often the treatment plan will involve the use of a splint, physiotherapy and general advice on self-care.

You may need to contact your GP for a referral to physiotherapy if the consultant thinks this is needed.

We will also send a copy of your notes and X-Ray report to your GP.
